Once payment is received, you will get an official registration form in your PayPal registered email inbox. Upon receipt of this e-mail, your seat is confirmed. I will periodically update the webpage with registration counts and the seats are available on a first come first serve basis. If less than 10 people register for this workshop by February 29, 2020, we reserve the right to cancel the class. If that happens, refunds will be processed to those individuals that have paid in advance. If the seats fill up, we will maintain a wait list for any interested individual in the case of cancellations. Refunds will be offered until 30 days prior to the event less any fees incurred by PayPal. A refund will forfeit your seat and it will be offered to the next available individual.

Rain or Shine

This event will happen rain or shine. The workshop will be held indoors but this is a dark sky facility and we will be taking advantage of what this facility has to offer if weather permits. As always with what we do, clouds and bad weather can happen.

Mounts and Your Equipment

Due to the nature of different mounts, cameras and telescopes, we will not cover instruction on how to setup and use your own equipment if you do not know how to use it. This workshop will be targeted toward individuals who wish to learn more about the processing aspect of astrophotography. You really should at least know how to acquire raw data from your equipment in order to take full advantage of this workshop. If you wish to learn more about your own equipment and how to use it, I offer personal one on one instruction for those interested. Please contact me privately about these offerings.

Star Party Etiquette

This workshop will maintain a star party atmosphere in the evening. General star party behavior will apply such as no loud music, red lights only after dark and vehicles in or out on an as needed basis. Lasers are only permitted by staff for instructional purposes.
